President Kasinger stated how important it is for us to fill this role immediately due to needing a clerk treasurer to be able to have any meetings moving forward.


It was mentioned that Melissa would need to resign from her position as town council member and that position would be filled by the head of the republican party just as she filled the previous vacancy.

President Kasinger made a motion to accept Melissa's resignation from the Town Council. Shad Akers seconded that motion. Brad Cagle voted in favor. Melissa abstained from the vote. All in favor 3-0.

Jesse made a motion that the meeting be adjourned.




