TOWN BOARD MEETING – SHELburn COMMUNITY BUILDING
AUGUST 9, 2022

The meeting was called to order by President Jesse Kasinger at 6:00pm with members Brad Cagle, Alex Norris, John Curtis, and Jesse Kasinger all in attendance.

Clerk Treasurer Melissa Copeland read the minutes of the meeting held on July 21, 2022. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Jesse Kasinger with a second by Brad Cagle, all in favor.

Town Manager Dustin Geatches presented a Financial Commitment letter for INDOT for the council to approve. A motion was made by Council Member Alex Norris to accept the INDOT Financial Commitment letter, seconded by Council Member Brad Cagle, all in favor.

Town Manager Dustin Geatches presented a letter for the Sullivan County Commissioners for waiving the tap fees at the new county jail. A motion was made by Council Member Alex Norris to accept the INDOT Financial Commitment letter, seconded by Council Member Brad Cagle, all in favor.

Due to the resignation of Melissa Copeland from the Redevelopment Commission at a previous Town Council Meeting, the Town Council had to appoint a new member to the Commission. They received one letter of intent from Heather Lewis. Motion was made to appoint Heather Lewis to the Shelburn Redevelopment Commission by Council Member Brad Cagle, seconded by Alex Norris, all in favor.

Clerk-Treasurer Melissa Copeland brought forward Ordinance 2022-09-13 for the Town Council to review and approve sending to Town Attorney Terry Modesitt for his approval. Motion was made to send the ordinance for review from Council Member Brad Cagle, seconded by Alex Norris, all in favor.

A motion was made by Council President Jesse Kasinger to move the remaining Town Council Monthly Meeting dates from the second Monday of the month to the second Tuesday of the month, seconded by Alex Norris, all in favor.


