

TOWN OF SHELburn
TOWN BOARD MEETING – SHELburn COMMUNITY BUILDING
December 13, 2022

The meeting was called to order by President Jesse Kasinger at 6:00pm with members Brad Cagle, John Curtis, and President Jesse Kasinger all in attendance. Council Member Alex Norris joined the meeting late at 6:09pm.

Clerk Treasurer Melissa Copeland read the minutes of the meeting held on November 15, 2022 all minutes were approved by the Town Council.

Clerk Treasurer Melissa Copeland presented two quotes for Employee Health Insurance for the 2023 Calendar Year. The quotes were put together by Springer Insurance. The first quote was from United Healthcare for a monthly cost of \$3,479.42. The second quote was from Anthem BlueCross BlueShield for a monthly cost of \$2,494.40. Council Member John Curtis made a motion to approve Anthem Insurance as the Insurance Company for the Employee Policy, seconded by Council Member Cagle. All in favor. Vote passed 3-0. Council Member Alex Norris had not arrived yet and was not present to vote.

Council Member Alex Norris made a motion to have the old bank property appraised and surveyed and a new legal description created for the property, seconded by Brad Cagle. All in favor.

A motion to approve the claim voucher was made by Council Member Alex Norris with a second by Brad Cagle. All in Favor.

Council Member Cagle made a motion to accept the Personal Property Rental Agreement from the Shelburn Police Department Reserve Association Corp. for the use of the Shelburn Community Building for their weekly Bingo games for the year of 2023, seconded by Alex Norris. All in favor.


