

## TOWN OF SHELburn

TOWN BOARD MEETING – SHELburn COMMUNITY BUILDING  
May 9, 2023

The meeting was called to order by Council President Jesse Kasinger at 6:00pm with members Brad Cagle, John Curtis, and Council President Jesse Kasinger, all in attendance. Council Member Alex Norris was not in attendance at the beginning of the meeting and arrived at 6:28pm.

Clerk Treasurer Melissa Copeland read the minutes of the meeting held on April 11, 2023, all minutes were approved by the Town Council.

An opportunity was given to allow any community members in attendance to speak on behalf of the town, possibly considering a Town Wide Trash Service. There were no public comments.

Council Member Brad Cagle made a motion to accept the 2023 Mowing Agreement, seconded by John Curtis. All in Favor.

Council Member Brad Cagle made a motion to rescind their vote made at the April 11<sup>th</sup> Town Council meeting where they voted to not approve the EDA Extension Request, seconded by Jesse Kasinger. All in Favor.

Council President Jesse Kasinger made a motion for Clerk Treasurer to work on an amendment for the current ordinance which states residents of the town are not allowed to have poultry, seconded by Brad Cagle. All in Favor.

Clerk Treasurer Melissa Copeland presented the Town Council with six invoices that were dropped off in her office at the end of April by Town Marshal Matthew Price. They were for a total of \$3263.66. (Mace Ford \$746.94, Municipal Electronics Division LLC \$110.00, Carahsoft Technology Corp. \$528.00, Edge Information Technologies \$360.00, Caliber Public Safety \$1103.00, and a reimbursement to Marshal Price for a purchase he made on Ebay of \$415.72) A motion was made by Council Member Brad Cagle to accept and pay these invoices, seconded by John Curtis. All in Favor.

A representative from the Shelburn Old Fashioned Days Association Corporation attended the Council Meeting and asked if the Town Council would be willing to pay the \$300 rental fee that the owner of the Slab and Stage require for them to have the Shelburn Old Fashioned Days Festival this year. They also asked if the Town would approve closing Griffith Street from Washington St. to Interurban St. as well as closing down Interurban St. from Griffith St. to Mill St. during the two-day event. Council President Jesse Kasinger made a motion to pay the \$300 rental fee for the use of the stage and slab as well as closing the two roads for the two-day event, seconded by John Curtis. All in Favor.

Shelburn Park Board Vice President Danielle Schaulburg presented updated Rules for the Shelburn Ball Diamond. Town Council Member Brad Cagle made a motion to accept these new rules, seconded by John Curtis. All in favor.

6:28pm Alex Norris joined the meeting.

A motion was made by Brad Cagle to approve a payment of \$943.96 to Best Buy for the purchase of two computer screens and two external hard drives that Town Marshal Matthew Price charged to the Best Buy Business Account, seconded by Alex Norris. All in Favor.

A motion to approve the claim voucher was made by Council President Jesse Kasinger, with a second by Council Member Alex Norris. All in Favor.

At 7:04pm a motion was made by Council President Jesse Kasinger to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Brad Cagle. All in favor.


